In accordance with Article 9-d of the Aviation Act ("Official Gazette of the Republic of Macedonia" No. 14/06, 24/07, 103/08, 67/10, 24/12, 80/12, 155/12, 42/14, 97/15, 152/15, 27/16 and 31/16) as well as Article 8, paragraph 2 of the Regulation on the specific conditions, manner and procedure for obtaining flight permissions ("Official Gazette of the Republic of Macedonia" No. 38/13, 131/15 and 131/16), the Director General of the Civil Aviation Agency has taken the following

**DECISION**  
**on establishment of the Summer Season 2017 Time-table**

1. Herewith the IATA Summer Season 2017 Time-table (enclosed to this Decision), *i.e.* the period from 26 March until 28 October 2017, of all scheduled airlines operating to/from the Republic of Macedonia is established.
2. The airlines shall operate their scheduled air services in the international air traffic in accordance with the international agreements binding to the Republic of Macedonia, the Aviation Act, ("Official Gazette of the Republic of Macedonia" No. 14/06, 24/07, 103/08, 67/10, 24/12, 80/12, 155/12, 42/14, 97/15, 152/15, 27/16 and 31/16) and the Contract Law in Aviation ("Official Gazette of the Republic of Macedonia" No. 85/08, 148/11, 10/15, 150/15 and 173/15) as well as other applicable regulations of the Republic of Macedonia.
3. The airlines shall be obliged according to Article 37, paragraph 3 of the Aviation Act, ("Official Gazette of the Republic of Macedonia" No. 14/06, 24/07, 103/08, 67/10, 24/12, 80/12, 155/12, 42/14, 97/15, 152/15, 27/16 and 31/16) to submit to the Civil Aviation Agency monthly reports on their air services regularity, containing data on performed flights, number of passengers carried, as well as other details providing a proper monitoring of the air traffic.
4. The airlines shall be subject to SAFA inspections by the Civil Aviation Agency according to the Working Arrangement between the Civil Aviation Agency of the Republic of Macedonia and EASA and the Regulation on Public Air Transport Oversight ("Official Gazette of the Republic of Macedonia" No. 8/14 and 16/17) including transposed EU Regulations on SAFA inspections.
5. The airlines shall operate their scheduled air services in the international air traffic in accordance with the applicable regulations for passenger

rights and shall be subject to inspection by the Civil Aviation Agency of the Republic of Macedonia according to the "Regulation on procedure, rules and special requirements for inspection of the protection of passenger rights in aviation and special requirements to be met by a person to carry out inspection ("Official Gazette of the Republic of Macedonia" No. 215/16).

6. In accordance with the present Decision, individual flight permissions shall be issued to all foreign airlines specified in the present Decision.
7. Any failure by the airlines to comply with the above-mentioned obligations shall result in withdrawal of the flight permission granted.
8. The present Decision shall enter into force on the day of its signature and apply from 26 March 2017.
